Classes 1 and 2 students participated in Budding Scientists activities based on various themes like water, air, pollution etc.

Class wise projects were also taken up such as soil conservation, reducing the consumption of fuels, plant life, bridges and vaccinations etc.

## Mathematics Department 2019 – 2020

### • BRICS MATH COMPETITION

Brics Math online competition is organized by the Central Board of Secondary Education. The goal was to develop students' analytical and reasoning skills and encourage their interest in math. It was for the first time the students appeared for the online exam. As the competition does not require any in-depth knowledge of the school curriculum so the students enjoyed participating in the exam. The fun and interactive task of the competition made the students think outside the box. The competition had three rounds: Preparatory Round, Trial Round and the Main Round. All the participants were awarded with the certificates when they cleared all the three rounds.

- **Aryabhata Competition organised by CBSE:** Students of class IX participated in the competition and cleared for the round 2 also.
- **NTSE / JSTSE:** many students have participated in the competition though they did not score much satisfactory.
- **Olympiad:** students of class I to XII participate every year in the Olympiad. Few of them cleared for the second round also.
- **Aryabhata National Maths Competition.** **Aryabhata** Inter-School Mathematics Competition is a prestigious competition conducted by the **Summer Fields School, Kailash Colony, New Delhi**. The students from Grade V participated in it. The main aim of this **examination** was to explore budding mathematicians and motivate them to hone their skills. Total 11 students were selected from Grade V and the selection was on the basis of

screen test. Extra classes were conducted on every Friday and Saturday for 1 hour where the concepts or topics in the syllabus were explained to the students and thereafter worksheets were given for practice.

- Mathematics month was celebrated in which students participated in various competitions like inter house origami paper folding competition, Doodling, Tessellation, Tangram making. Inter class Display board competitions was also organised in which children enthusiastically decorated the display board on various mathematical topics. Math debate was organised by the school on the topics 'Is Math important in this world of Science and Technology'.
