SAFETY ADVISORY ON PREVENTION AND FIRST AID RELATED TO STRAY DOGS

Dear Parents and Students

Greetings!

In the interest of student safety and well-being we share an **Advisory** as below:

Key Safety Guidelines:

- Remain calm and composed around stray dogs; **do not run or shout.**
- Avoid direct eye contact, sudden movements, or actions that may be perceived as threatening.
- Maintain a safe distance and move away slowly if a stray dog approaches.
- Never approach or confront a group of dogs.
- Children should always be supervised and advised **not to feed, tease, or attempt to touch stray animals.**

In Case of a Bite or Scratch:

- Wash the wound immediately with soap and clean water.
- Inform parents/teachers at once and seek medical attention without delay.
- Follow medical advice for further treatment, including rabies prevention if required.

The school continues to take necessary preventive measures on campus and seeks your cooperation in reinforcing these safety practices with children at home as well.

Together, through awareness and responsible behaviour, we can ensure a safer environment for everyone.
