# STELLAR CBSE BOARD RESULTS

G. D. Goenka Public School, Sec 10 Dwarka, has demonstrated a period of profound scholastic excellence, celebrating the consummate achievements of its Class X and Class XII cohorts for the 2024-25 session. Both classes achieved a flawless 100% pass percentage, a definitive attestation to the institution's academic rigour. The Class XII batch, comprising 179 students, led with a remarkable school average of 86%, further illuminated by 71 students transcending the 90% threshold and an impressive 36 perfect centums across diverse subjects. The top honours were claimed by Niharika Sehgal and Rishita Singh (98.0%) in the Science stream, Palak Makhijani (97.8%) in Commerce, and Vanshita Batra (97.8%) in Humanities.

The Class X batch of 182 students mirrored this success, securing a commendable 83% school average, with 56 students scoring above 90% and 22 instances of perfect 100s. Individual brilliance shone brightly, with Bhoomi Dhami (98.6%) reaching the academic pinnacle for Class X.
